

## EgertonNP Policy P2 - Local Green Spaces

**Local Green Space, as defined on Maps xxxx, preserve the open green character of the parish, provide wildlife habitats and have local amenity value.**

**Proposals for development will not be allowed in a designated Local Green Space unless they are ancillary to, and support, the use of the land for the purpose for which it was designated as Local Green Space.**

### Notes to support or explain this policy:

The final Neighbourhood Plan will include a list, and maps, of designated green spaces which have been identified through consultation and then reviewed in a formal Green Space Assessment by our consultants, South Downs Planning Authority.

The Plan will also note the importance to the overall character of the village of grass verges and other natural features.

The consultants have identified the following three sites for designation;



The Glebe



Green spaces, Elm Close



Upper Recreation ground



Lower Recreation ground
